has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Cahaba, Alabama* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *William Frost,*

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section two, in Township ten, of Range fifteen in the District of Lands Subject to sale at Cahaba, Alabama, containing *Forty one acres, and thirty hundredths of an acre.*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *William Frost.*
